## **OHIO TECHCRED: APPLICATION CHECKLIST**



The Ohio TechCred program provides employers an opportunity to upskill current and prospective employees in SolidWorks through grant-funded training.



Businesses of all sizes, from any industry, are eligible for up to \$30,000 per application round and up to \$180,000 per year. Once approved, the State of Ohio will reimburse 100% of training costs – up to \$2,000 per credential – for completed training. Prior to starting your application, you will need to gather the following information:

### **Credential Information**

Review GoEngineer's training catalog to help identify your team's needs and budget. Once you've determined needs and the number of students for each course (i.e., credential), request a quote from your Account Manager for easy reference in your application.
