

# OHIO TECHCRED: APPLICATION CHECKLIST



The Ohio TechCred program provides employers an opportunity to upskill current and prospective employees in SolidWorks through grant-funded training.



Businesses of all sizes, from any industry, are eligible for up to **\$30,000 per application round** and up to **\$180,000 per year**. Once approved, the State of Ohio will reimburse 100% of training costs – up to **\$2,000 per credential** – for completed training. Prior to starting your application, you will need to gather the following information:
